#### GRANT WRITING WORKSHOP SCHEDULED AUGUST 24

A grant writing workshop is scheduled to be presented in Clarion August 24 for representatives of nonprofits, local government and schools.

Grant Writing 101 will provide hands-on training in seeking and writing successful grant applications. The workshop will be presented from 5:30 to 8:30 p.m. Thursday, August 24 at the Wright County Extension office, 210 1st Street SW, Clarion. The workshop is sponsored by Iowa State University Extension – Wright County, and Wright County Economic Development.

Participants are encouraged to bring a laptop, iPad or tablet device to the workshop, if they have one available.

Cost of the workshop is \$20, which includes a light meal served at the start of the program. The registration deadline is August 22; contact Sarah Seymour at 515-532-3453 or <a href="mailto:seymour1@iastate.edu">seymour1@iastate.edu</a> to register.

The training will be presented by Jane Nolan Goeken, a Community and Economic Development program specialist with Iowa State University Extension and Outreach. She has also served as a grant application reviewer and has helped set up grant award and review programs.

Goeken will assist workshop participants in exploring various public and private funding sources, and provide instruction and tips on planning projects and writing successful grant applications.
